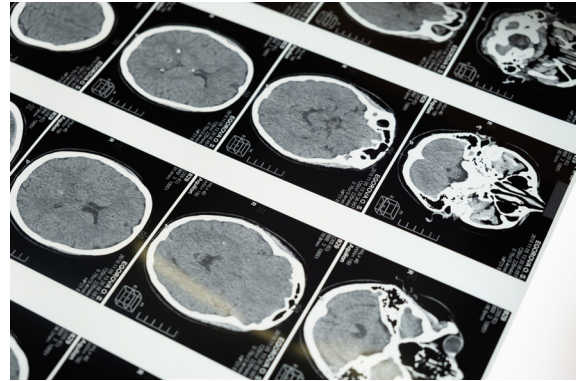


COMPANY SPOTLIGHT PRO MEDICUS (PME)

Medical imaging has developed significantly over the last decade and now plays a crucial role in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases such as heart disease, stroke and cancer¹. The imaging is time-consuming work and requires data-intensive communication processes. Radiologists in the US for instance can look at anywhere between 20 and 100 scans per day, and each can have thousands of images to review². Efficient imaging technology is required to reduce this time-intensive process.

Pro Medicus (PME) provides PACS (Picture Archiving and Communication Systems) and RIS (Radiology Information Systems) technology to radiologists in the US. Their Visage 7 (PACS) technology enables radiologists to access medical images more efficiently and the AI tools currently under development are also expected to support radiologists in making more accurate diagnoses, providing a first 'screen' on images, and reducing the occurrence of missed diagnoses.

Melior is focussed on advocating for Pro Medicus to set emissions targets (now that they have completed a Scope 1 & 2 emissions inventory), improve on board and management gender diversity targets and ensure an effective cyber security strategy is in place.
